Richard Flaum, a partner in the firm, has settled a federal lawsuit he brought on behalf of the parents of a 6th grade boy with a severe peanut allergy that was filed in response to a school district's refusal to allow the boy to bring to school a service dog trained to detect peanuts. At the age of 4 or 5, the boy spent 5 days in a life threatening coma caused by airborne exposure to peanut proteins.
